Following the introduction of Windows 11, Forrester Consulting conducted a Total Economic Impact (TEI) study to examine the potential return on investment (ROI) organisations may gain by developing Windows 11. The study provided a framework to evaluate the potential financial impact of Windows 11 across organisations, identifying several benefits:

Improvement in end-user productivity: using Windows 11 increased productivity by up to 15% in the average end user. This benefit is rooted in the new features of Windows 11, allowing users to customise their workspaces, improve processing times, and drive application developement





Enhanced security of the OS environment: by using Windows 11, OS environments are more secure from malware and ransomware threats. Windows 11 has introduced specific security features targeting users that work in a hybrid or remote manner. Over three years, organisations have been able to improve the risk profile of their OS environments by up to 30% per year

Operational efficiency: organisations have realised certain operational efficiency gains in their IT processes after migrating to Windows 11. As Windows 11 comes with several self-service features, organisations have seen the number of OS-related help desk requests decrease by as much as 90% per year after a period of adjustment. Additionally, the improvement in the OS environment security introduced by Windows 11 allowed organisations to reduce spending on third-party security software licensing by up to 10%



Top tips for a successful deployment


Windows 11 is built on the foundations of Windows 10, making the deployment as simple as a Microsoft 10 update. You will still have access to all your applications and management experiences to ensure a smooth integration.

Creating a migration plan for Windows 11 is an important process for organisations who are ready to take the next step, gaining the new features and capabilities. There are some core fundamentals that must be considered to ensure a successful deployment:


- Determine eligibility: before you integrate Windows 11, you need to check that all devices meet the hardware requirements and can be upgraded to Windows 11
- Prepare readiness content: to ensure your update goes smoothly, you need to make readiness content easily digestible for everyone, using the tools you have access to today
- • Evaluate infrastructure and tools: review and update your deployment infrastructure and tools that are used to deploy and manage Windows devices.

 Ensure that they support Windows 11 and can handle the upgrade process smoothly before you take next steps
- • • Determine application readiness: test and validate the compatibility of applications that are used in your organisation with Windows 11. Use services and tooling to deliver automated pre-deployment testing for any Windows application
- Define readiness criteria: set the criteria for determining when a device is ready to be upgraded to Windows 11. Consider factors such as user feedback, device performance, application compatibility, security compliance, and business needs
- Define servicing strategy: choose the servicing channel and cadence for updating Windows 11 devices to decide how to handle feature updates, quality updates, and security updates

By following these steps, your organisation will create a migration plan for Windows 11 that suits your needs and goals, achieving a successful and seamless transition to the new operating system.

Windows 11 23H2 release

In September 2023, Windows 11 received a major update with the release of 23H2, which brought several new features and improvements to the OS, such as:

- • Windows Copilot: a new feature in Windows 11 that adds AI capabilities to help users find answers, complete tasks, and be more productive. It uses Bing Chat Enterprise, a generative AI model that can understand natural language and create content such as summaries, images, and code
- People: a new experience that makes it easier to find and connect with relevant contacts on Teams, as well as access contacts synced by users from other sources
- New File Explorer: a redesigned File Explorer that has a cleaner and more modern look, with new icons, context menus, and command bar. The File Explorer also supports 7zip and RAR files natively, as well as RGB Dark mode
- ••• Windows Backup: a new feature that lets users backup their files and settings to OneDrive or an external drive, and restore them easily if needed. Windows Backup also supports incremental backups and version history

Windows 11 23H2 is a significant update that enhances the user experience and productivity of Windows 11. It also shows Microsoft's commitment to delivering regular updates to its OS and keeping it fresh and innovative.
