Key differences between E3 and E5

Microsoft 365 E3 and E5 are both enterprise-level Microsoft licensing options that include Office 365 (O365), Windows 10 and 11, and Enterprise Mobility and Security (EM&S) services. All of the core capabilities are the same, but E5 has advanced security and compliance features.

The core capabilities include:

- O365 E3 Including M365 Apps, One Drive, SharePoint etc
- EM&S E3 Including Intune P1 and Entra ID P1
- Windows 11
- Defender for Endpoint P1


